The Issuer was informed by Zabrzanskie Zaklady Mechaniczne S.A. (the Issuer subsidiary) on gaining permission No 267 by Zabrzanskie Zaklady Mechaniczne S.A. to carry out activities within Katowice Special Economic Zone; scope of the activities covers production, trading and rendering services, in relevance with the following products to be manufactured within the Zone:

- 29.5 other special purpose machinery
- 28 ready- made metal products,

in accordance with The Polish Classification of Goods and Services /*PKWiU*/ of the Central Statistical Office /*GUS*/. The permission in question is valid until 8 August 2016.

The following conditions of carrying out economic activities have been determined:

- 1. - 3. The project will be completed unitl 31 December 2011.
